Drug Alert for Huron and Perth CountiesSuspected fentanyl overdose deaths

Issued: June 5, 2023

The Huron Perth Drug Strategy partners are reporting 4 overdose deaths in the last 2 weeks.

3 deaths have occurred June 1 – 4, 2023. There have been multiple near fatal overdoses also reported during this time in Huron Perth and Grey Bruce counties.

There is concern about drug potency <u>and</u> drugs being cut with other substances such as benzodiazepines and / or Xylazine (animal tranquilizer) causing death. Fentanyl is the suspected drug used in the recent deaths

Safety Messaging:

- Don't use alone
- Carry naloxone
- Start slow with a test dose
- Call 911 and stay with the overdosing person
- Connect to services: medications and treatments for people with opioid use disorder

Free naloxone kits are available across Huron and Perth at: Pharmacies, CMHA and Huron Perth Public Health
